From The Diary of St. Faustina

Meditation:

I heard a voice in my soul: These words are for you. Do all you possibly can for this work of My mercy. I desire that My mercy be worshiped, and I am giving mankind the last hope of salvation; that is, recourse to My mercy. My Heart rejoices in this feast. After these words, I understood that nothing can dispense me from the obligation which the Lord demands from me (*Diary*, 998).

My Prayer Response:

Lord Jesus, help me and all souls to *worship* Your mercy and to have recourse to Your mercy as the last hope of salvation for mankind.

I Believe in Jesus Christ, His Only Son Our Lord -

(CCC 438) Jesus' messianic consecration reveals his divine mission, "for the name 'Christ' implies 'he who anointed', 'he who was anointed' and 'the very anointing with which he was anointed'. The one who anointed is the Father, the one who was anointed is the Son, and he was anointed with the Spirit who is the anointing." [St. Irenaeus, Adv. haeres. 3,18,3: PG 7/1, 934] His eternal messianic consecration was revealed during the time of his earthly life at the moment of his baptism by John, when "God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power", "that he might be revealed to Israel" [Acts 10:38; Jn 1:31] as its Messiah. His works and words will manifest him as "the Holy One of God". [Mk 1:24; Jn 6:69; Acts 3:14] [727, 535]

In the Great Jubilee year of 2000, 25 Years ago, Pope John Paull II declared the Feast of Divine Mercy! Entrusting the whole world to the Divine Mercy of God. This is a message of Trust in God and a Hope for renewal in accepting God's.
